For this purpose, our multicultural team of staterecognized social workers and educators provides you and your relatives with a wide range of individually tailored psychosocial support measures, assistance, counseling and various other services in your living environment.



We can support you at:

- finding your own apartment
- · dealing with money, authorities, caregivers, doctors
- organizing your everyday life
- finding and maintaining a meaningful day center
- preserving and strengthening your health and emotional stability
- coping with social conflicts, life crises and trauma
- establishing and shaping social relationships
- enabling social participation
- finding work, school, training, further education and leisure activities
- expanding your mobility, observing leisure, cultural and religious activities outside your home
- and many more ...

WHO CAN WE SUPPORT?

Our services can be obtained by all persons of legal age who:

- have one or more physical, mental or psychological limitations
- are at least 18 years old
- have their place of residence in the Offenbach district
- have a residence permit *
- live or want to live in their own apartment, with their parents, with their partner or in a shared apartment
- can recieve integration assistance benefits in accordance German Social Assistance Act (Section 90 SGB XI ff.)

(* If you have been living in Germany continuously for at least 18 months, in exceptional cases we can help you even without a residence permit. Let us advise you!)

TARGET GROUP & COSTS

The central requirement for receiving services from ASESIT is an entitlement to integration assistance according to the German Social Assistance Act on integration assistance (§§ 90-150 SGB IX). The legal right to integration assistance exists for all physically, mentally and/or psychologically handicapped people, provided that their impairments are not only temporary.

Our work is carried out according to the objectives and framework of the new Person-centered Integrated Participation-plan (PiT) as applied in the supra-local social welfare provider, the Hessian State Welfare Association (LWV).

If necessary, ASESIT will handle the application and support you in discussions with the service provider to determine your needs. The same service providor (usually the LWV also pays the costs for the assistance, whereby the scope of the approved benefits depends on the applicant's income and assets.

There is also the option of paying for the costs as a self-payer as part of a private contract.

ASESIT Outpatient Assisted Living (short: "ASESIT") is a private provider of integration assistance in the Offenbach district.

Our main goal is to give people with diabilities the greatest possible space for free and self-determined development of their individual life opportunities. In addition we are committed to expand intercultural competences and migrant representation in german social work.
